### 2019 ITTA Open Championships – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. ELIGIBILITY** – The championships are open to all, both university and non-university students.
- 2. MAXIMUM EVENTS:** All players are eligible to enter the open singles events for their respective gender. For the division events, a player may only play in a maximum of 2 sequential Division Singles events if eligible to play in both events. **The maximum number of events a player can enter on the day is 3.**
- 3. EQUIPMENT:** White Plastic 40+ balls shall be used in the Tournament.
- 4. I.T.T.F. rules** will apply to clothing, rackets, gluing, equipment and control of the tournament generally. Any query of the legality or acceptability of playing attire shall be decided by the Tournament Referee. Gluing is not permitted within the stadium. The main colour of the clothing shall not be WHITE. Tracksuits are not to be worn without the permission of tournament control.
- 5. REGISTRATION:** All players must register and pay entry fees BEFORE the day of the tournament. Upon arrival players are to check in at the tournament control desk. **Payment of fees on the day of the tournament will incur a \$10 surcharge.** (See page 3 for further information)
- 6. REFUSAL OF ENTRY:** The Tournament directors reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse entry into the tournament by any player. If the Tournament directors exercises this option, it will notify the player accordingly and refund any monies paid.
- 7. EVENT FORMAT:** All matches are the best of 5 games (except in knockout stage onwards in the Mens/Womens Open Singles). All events will be played in round robin groups of 3 with winners advancing to knockout format. (for avoidance of doubt, this format may be altered where there are insufficient or unequal numbers in an event).
- 8. OPEN SINGLES:** All Men's and Women's Open singles matches shall be best of 7 games from the knockout stage onwards
- 9. DIVISION EVENTS:** Are open to players not rated above the points stated for the particular Division according to Ratings Central Points as at the closing date for entries (**27<sup>TH</sup> February 2019**).
- Any players who have no rating points or ranking and have little to no competition experience should enter Division 3. Discretion will be used if a player who is clearly not below 800 points in terms of standard will be removed from that event.
- Tournament Control shall have sole management of the Championships and their decisions are final. All players will submit to ITTA's jurisdiction with respect to any disciplinary matter that occurs during, or arises out of, this tournament.
- 12. CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:** Tournament Control shall have the power to cancel any event which attracts insufficient entries, and to vary any conditions as it may deem necessary. Players entering an event which is cancelled, or for which they are not eligible, will be placed in an alternative event if one is suitable.
- 13. SCORESHEETS & UMPIRING:** Upon collecting the score sheet, players should take an umpire to the table. If unable to find an umpire please see tournament control immediately. Winning players must check, sign, & return the score sheet to the office immediately upon completion of matches. A maximum 2 minute hit up is allowed prior to commencement of a match. All players must assist by umpiring when requested. Any player not ready to play when called may be disqualified by the tournament control,
- 14. REFUND & "NO SHOW" POLICY:** No refunds shall be allowed to players withdrawing during events. Once Events have been published, refunds also may not be provided. Players who fail to show and have not paid will be invoiced outstanding amount, which includes any pay on day levies.
- 15. LATE ENTRIES:** Acceptance of late entries is at the discretion of Tournament Control
